Rainbow Village's New Partners

Until 1993, Rainbow Village partnered with one support service agency. As we continued to grow, we began working with more agencies and today we are fortunate to work with 14 support service agency partners! Our newest partners are **Community Choice Inc.** and **Austen-Dooley Company**.

Community Choice, an independently owned and operated business, formed in 1998. They provide residential services and personal care attendant services to individuals with disabilities who wish to live in the community. The Community Choice mission is to enhance the quality of life for individuals with disabilities by ensuring that they have opportunities to achieve their greatest potential through quality residential living and staffing supports. They currently have two residents living in a Rainbow home in St. Peters.

Austen-Dooley was started in Lee's Summit, Missouri, in 2001. The company's goal is to provide support services that will enable individuals with developmental disabilities to achieve and maintain physical well being, pursue personal satisfaction, and participate as family and community members. In 2005, Austen-Dooley expanded into the St. Louis area and in 2010, began their partnership with Rainbow Village. They provide support services to one resident in a home in Hazelwood.

Our Community Relations Coordinator, Jessica, joined Rainbow Village's staff of 11 in July. She has already proven to be a valuable co-worker by organizing many groups for volunteer projects and updating social media for Rainbow.
